

MIKAELA'S STORY

On September 19, 2012, Mikaela was diagnosed with AML, an aggressive form of leukemia. Despite life threatening complications, Mikaela successfully went into remission in early 2013. After missing most of her freshman year in high school due to being hospitalized, Mikaela enjoyed returning to school for her sophomore year and working at Many Point Scout Camp.

When she returned from camp in late August 2014, she learned the devastating news that her cancer was back. The only viable treatment at this point for Mikaela is a bone marrow transplant. Because of the aggressive nature of her cancer, she is undergoing a transplant using umbilical cord blood from two donors. Thank you for helping to "pay it forward" through your willingness to join the bone marrow registry to help other children and adults. Without the kindness of strangers willing to donate, children like Mikaela would not be with us.
